

## How to Book a Rental at Danvers Indoor Sports and Entering and Exiting Procedures

To book a rental, please call DIS at 978-777-7529. If you do not have an account, please create an account by visiting www.danversindoorsports.com and clicking CREATE ACCOUNT/MEMBER LOGIN in the top right corner.

Following your booking, you will receive an email with instructions to share with your players.

Cash and check payments are not allowed at this time. Online and over the phone payments only to adhere to social distance guidelines. The safety of our employees and customers is always our top priority.

When arriving to DIS, please wait in your vehicle and enter the facility five minutes before your rental time ready to play with appropriate attire.

Upon entering the facility, wash hands in restrooms or use hand sanitizers available at point of entry.

There can be up to 25 players per playing surface.

Masks must be worn when entering and exiting the facility and in common areas such as benches, hallways and bathrooms. Masks can be removed when on playing surface if the space allows for social distancing.

There are no youth and adult spectators allowed at DIS during this time.

Please exit the facility immediately following your rental to allow for DIS staff to clean the areas and prepare for the next rental.

## Massachusetts Modifications to Guidelines effective August 17, 2020:

Deliberate close contact must be eliminated during play. Deliberate close contact includes but it not limited to collisions, body checking, tackling, blocking etc.

Game situations that result in intermittent close physical or face-to-face contact must be modified or eliminated, including: restarts, face-offs, throw-ins, scrums, or similar activities. These activities may be allowed if face masks are used during contact.

Participants are required to wear facial coverings at all times except for high intensity aerobic or anaerobic activities, when distancing of 6 feet or more is possible between participants; or for individuals that are unable to wear a face covering due to a medical condition or disability.
